1. 2nd MCV4 - Only 1 dose is required if MCV4 #1 was given on or after the 16th birthday
2. Hepatitis A – At least one Hep A is required by the start of the school year and an appointment date for the 2nd Hepatitis A. (Requires 2 doses given at least 6 months apart.)

**This is a reminder from the WHS Nurses that PowerSchool Parent Portal must be updated EVERY YEAR.**

- **If you have not updated medical information for your student, please submit info through the PARENT PORTAL of PowerSchool in order for your child to be treated in the health clinic.**
  - If your student comes to the clinic for treatment, we CANNOT administer over-the-counter medications or treatments, such as Ibuprofen, Acetaminophen, Benadryl, Hydrocortisone cream, etc. until you have updated PowerSchool.
  - We will not be calling parents for permission to give medications unless the student is significantly ill.
  - If you have difficulty with the PowerSchool Parent Portal, please contact the Central Office.
