What is ILEARN? Who takes it? What subject areas?

- Grades: 3-8, Biology
 - English/Language Arts (Grades 3-8)
 - Mathematics (Grades 3-8)
 - Science (Grades 4 and 6)
 - Social Studies (Grade 5)
 - Biology (High School)
- Two parts (non performance & performance tasks) for each content area
- Computer Adaptive Test (CAT)
- Universal Design
- Measures student growth and achievement according to Indiana Academic Standards

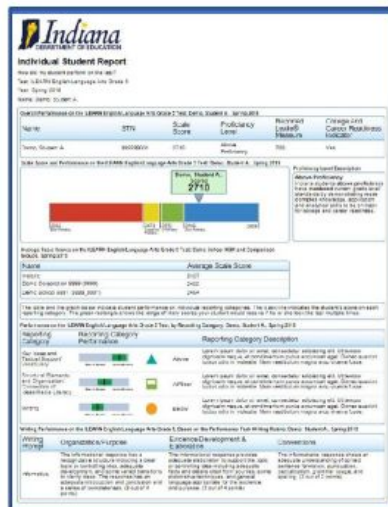

The ILEARN ISR

The ILEARN Individual Student Report (ISR) provides useful information about students' growth and proficiency, including:

- Basic Information and Overall Performance
- Student's Scale Score and Performance Level
- Average Scale Score and Comparison Groups
- Reporting Category
- Content Specific Information



New levels of proficiency replace Pass+, Pass, and Did Not Pass (tied to scale score)

- Below Proficiency
- Approaching Proficiency
- At Proficiency
- Above Proficiency

Comparison (of student to)

- School
- Corporation
- State

Other

- Academic Standards Performance
- Lexile-student's reading ability
- Quantile-student's math skills and understanding
- College and Career Readiness Indicator-based on IN standards

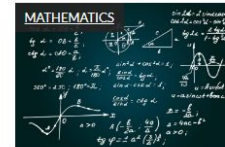
