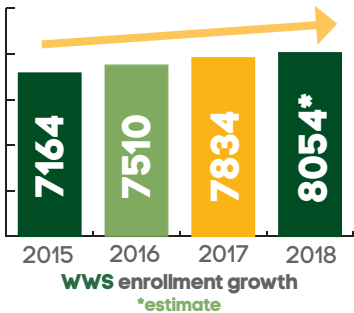
Our vision as a district is to be an exemplary learning organization focused on collaboration, innovation, and continuous growth for all.

8th Annual AP[®] District Honor Roll

For the **third consecutive year**, Westfield High School has been honored by the College Board in their 8th Annual AP District Honor Roll. Only 19 Indiana schools were recognized among the 447 named nationally for simultaneously achieving increases in access to Advanced Placement (AP) courses for a broader number of students and also maintaining or improving the rate at which their AP students earned scores of **3 or higher on an AP Exam**.
